On the Roman mosaic patterns

Origin

These three mosaic patterns appear on a floor mosaic at Fishbourne Roman Palace outside of Chichester in the UK. This black-and-white floor consists of 16 mosaic squares, some of which have survived underneath a later multi-coloured mosaic. All the squares are the same size, but internally they are divided into 8, 9 or 10 squares.
