T_EX and Meta:

the Good, the Bad and the Ugly Bits

That’s the theme of the 12th European T_EX conference, which will be held in Kerkrade in the Netherlands, from 23 to 27 September 2001.

So, what are “Good, Bad and Ugly Bits”? Traditionally we tend to focus on Good Bits because they are so rewarding. It feels good to see a beautifully typeset document that you were able to produce using all the power that T_EX and Metafont/MetaPost provide. We try to forget how many Bad Bits we had to overcome, and are proud that we found more or less elegant ways to program around them. Nevertheless, some of these difficulties should be regarded as Ugly Bits that would not exist in an ideal world. Well then what can we do?

- First of all, keep up the Good Bits and extend them if possible.
- Analyze the Bad Bits, learn from them, and find easy and generic ways to get around them.
- Find the Ugly Bits and eradicate them!

Let’s make progress! Of course we need a lot of discussion to distinguish between Good, Bad and Ugly, and about ways to deal with them. We invite you all to demonstrate or discuss either of these bits. Feel free to present your application (Good and/or Bad and/or Ugly) at the conference!

Program

Registration

In contrast to most other T_EX conferenties for EuroT_EX2001 we charge a flat fee that includes just about everything. No need to find a (much more expensive) hotel, no need to find a place to have lunch or dinner. It’s all arranged for you at the beautiful Rolduc site, so you get every opportunity to focus on T_EX and meet all the people you’ve been wanting to talk to. The fee includes:

- Lodging on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday on conference site
- Breakfast and lunch and dinner on Monday and Tuesday and Wednesday
- Conference proceedings
- A special social event in Maastricht

Note that the fee rises as the conference date approaches. The earlier you register the less you pay. However, you are always allowed to pay more :-). In that case your *name* will be listed as *sponsor* of the conference.

If you register early (i.e. before 1 January 2001) you will pay only 350 Euro. After 1 January the fee rises to 450 Euro; after 1 June it rises to 550, and after 1 August it rises to 650 Euro. Note that if you are *not* a member of any listed T_EX users group you will be charged an extra 150 Euro, so it’s really much more profitable to join NTG, TUG, Dante, UKTUG, or any of the other user groups. Accommodation
